The USPS® Office of Inspector General recently released an article about the price of a stamp: an international comparison. This article provides research and insights into how stamps have changed over the years.

"The U.S. Postal Service spends billions of dollars a year to deliver our nation's mail. These funds cover all aspects of its operations - such as overhead expenses, employee wages, and fleet maintenance costs - to deliver to every address in America. While some international posts receive government subsidies to fund their public service missions, the USPS does not. Instead, it relies almost entirely on postage revenue to cover its operations."
